Peer Review Board (PRB) is a conduct review board made up of residential UCR students. The purpose of PRB is to review conduct cases that originate in the residential community and to determine, from the information presented, what actually happened in the incident. Students on PRB work together to determine the proper outcome of conduct cases, and recommend appropriate sanctions. Application should be completed and submitted by **Friday December 9th, 2016 at 4pm** either by email to prb-housing@ucr.edu or in person to the Glen Mor RSO.

Requirements for Membership

In order to serve on PRB, Students must:

1. Be current full-time University of California, Riverside undergraduate or graduate students residing in University residence halls, campus apartments, or family housing
2. May not be currently serving as an Assistant Resident Director (ARD), Resident Advisor (RA), Program Coordinator (PC), or Academic Outreach Coordinator (AOC)
3. Possess and maintain 2.5 cumulative and quarterly GPA
4. Pass a successful completion of a background check. Be in good student conduct standing with University. Must not have student conduct history at UCR (university and housing student conduct records must be verified for successful application)
5. Attend all training sessions prior to participating in any committees.
