

## What Should I Bring to UCR?

There are a few essentials you don't want to be without.

- ✓ Your R'Card
- ✓ Pillows and bed linens for an extra-long twin bed.
- ✓ Alarm clock
- ✓ Laundry basket and detergent
- ✓ Wastebasket and bags
- ✓ Prescription drugs and medical items
- ✓ Personal toiletries (toothbrush, soap, shampoo, nail clippers, etc.) in a carrying case or bucket
- ✓ Towels and bathrobe
- ✓ Flashlight and batteries
- ✓ 3M Command Strips (for hanging room decor without damaging walls)
- ✓ Cell phone, charger and earbuds (like we had to remind you)
- ✓ Computer (laptop, tablet or desktop) and other personal electronics (don't forget cables and/or locks)
- ✓ UL-approved surge protector/power strip
- ✓ Desk and/or bedside lamp (no halogen)
- ✓ Favorite foods, snacks and drinks
- ✓ Microwave-safe cookware, dishes and utensils (BPA free)
- ✓ Cups
- ✓ Can opener
- ✓ Bicycle, skateboard or scooter. Don't forget a lock and helmet, too!
- ✓ Noise-canceling headphones
- ✓ Hangers
- ✓ Sewing Kit
- ✓ First Aid Kit, including Band-Aids.
- ✓ Umbrella
- ✓ Tissues and an extra roll of toilet paper
- ✓ Lint rollers
- ✓ School supplies

## What Should I Leave Home?

- ✗ Halogen lamp (fire hazard)
